## Respiratory system

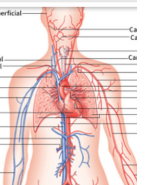
**Respiratory system** includes the **lungs** and the network of **airways** that connects them to the **nose** and **mouth**. The respiratory system is one of the body's major organ systems. The respiratory system handles the exchange of gases between the body and the environment. It functions to take from the air the oxygen needed for **respiration**. Cellular **respiration** is the process by which the body obtains energy from **glucose**, a simple sugar. **Respiration** produces a waste gas called **carbon dioxide**.

## Have students create a timeline!

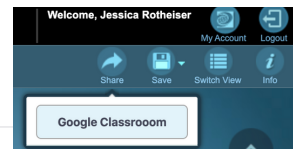
- Have students chronicle information, such as current events, in **Timelines**.
