### Share content with direct links!

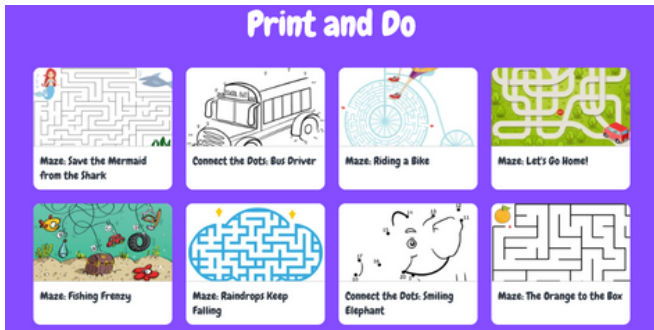


- Save your students time and make sure they find the correct resource by using direct links.
