## Going Back to School with Timelines



**Save and share Timelines with tools you already use!**

- Save timelines to Microsoft OneDrive, My Timelines, and My Research projects.
- Share timelines or create assignments directly with Google Classroom.
- Or simply share content using direct links!

### Build a Community:

Build a classroom community by having students create a timeline to tell about themselves and then take turns sharing with the class. Students can even upload their own pictures to complete their timeline!

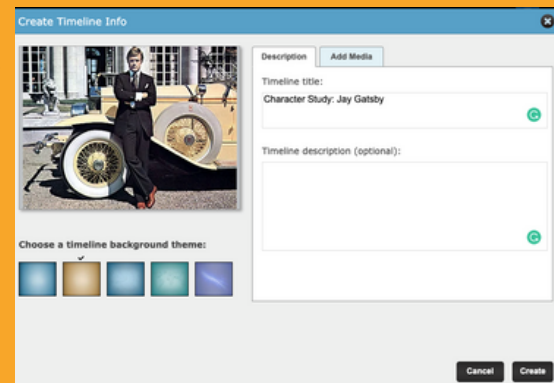


Have students create a timeline to use as a journal so they have a safe space to write about their life and their feelings.

### Reading:

Assign students a character or a novel and have them create a character study in a timeline.

Have students track their reading progress in timelines as a reading log that they can then share with you.



### Social Studies:

Have students personalize precreated timelines about historical events by adding or editing events and making notes based on their learning.



Create a timeline for students to write about current events and their thoughts around them.

### Writing:

Instead of keeping track of a notebook have students complete daily writing prompts in a timeline!
