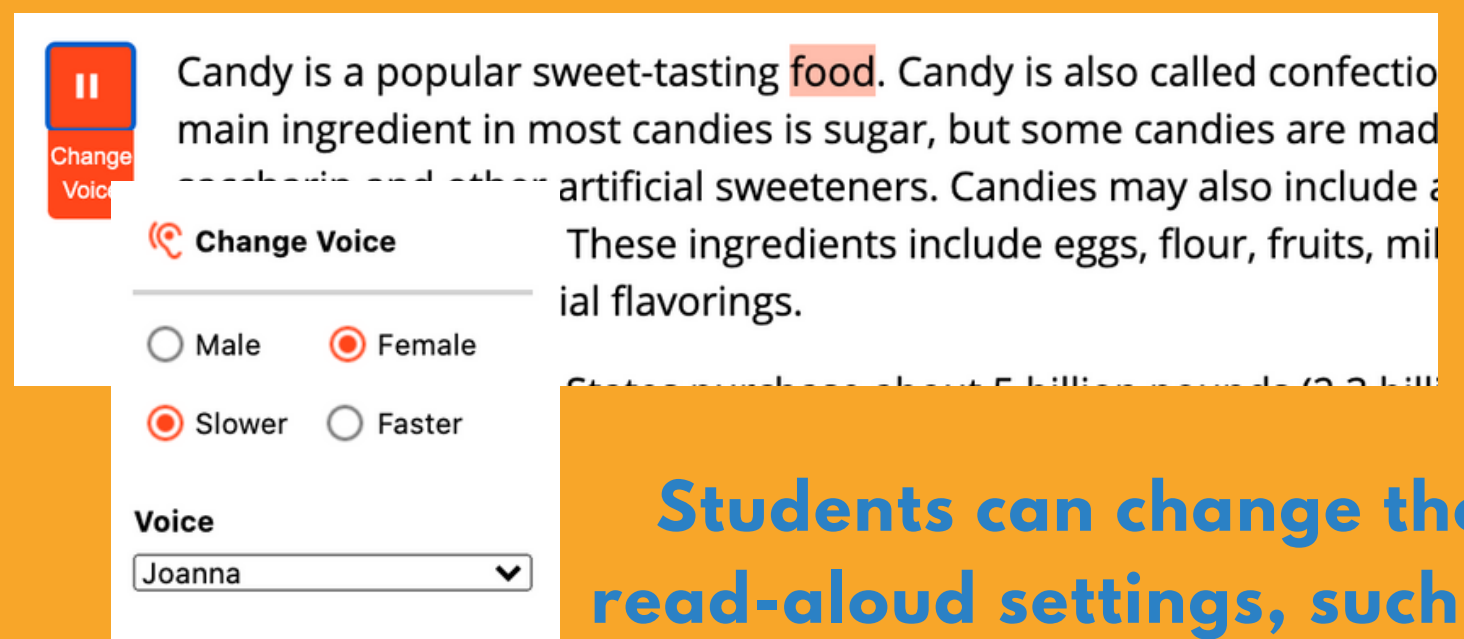
You clicked to define **confection**

Read-aloud:

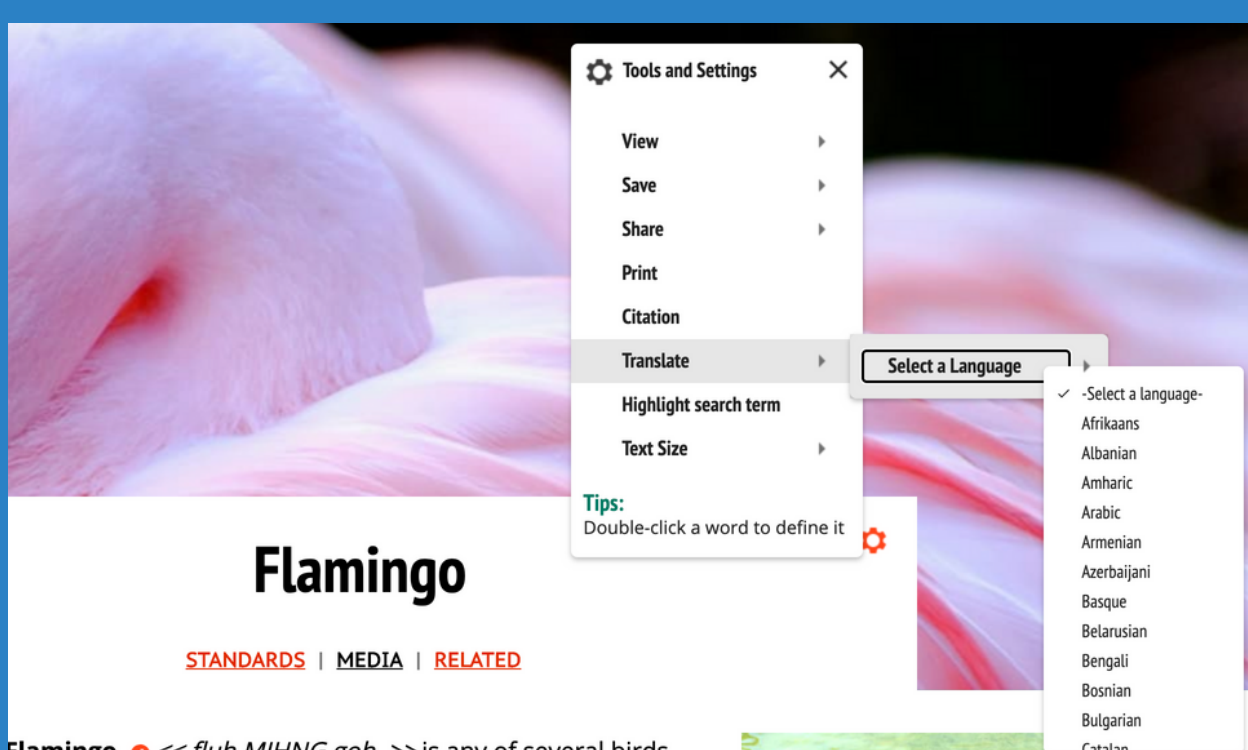
Every World Book article can be read-aloud. Students will see each word highlighted as the text is narrated.
